Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned G.P for the State. The learned counsel submits that the case was filed earlier as per provision existing in the earlier guidelines issued by ICDS directorate but now new guidelines 2011 is operative and in the subsequent amendment in the said guidelines, the appellate power is conferred upon District Magistrate to hear appeal in the matter relating to termination of engagement on the charges of misconduct in running the centre by Aanganbari functionaries. He also pleads that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant case.

2. In view of the submission and prayer made there to and keeping in view the amended provisions of the guidelines, this Court grants liberty to the counsel to withdraw the case and move before proper forum for redressal of his grievances and relief in accordance with the existing guidelines.

3. The appeal petition is disposed of accordingly.
